Fly of the Month – the Peabody



Hook: Tiemco 200R 12-18

Thread: Gray or olive

Body: 4-6 strands of Peacock hurl

Rib: Fine copper wire counterwound over hurl

Hackle: Brown hen hackle

Step 1:

Tie the thread on the hook and then tie in 4-6 strands of peacock hurl and the copper wire at the rear of the hook. Tie the brown hen hackle at the front of the shaft.



Step 2: Create a dubbing loop of thread and peacock hurl and wind towards to front of the hook.

Counterwind the copper wire rib over the hurl. Tie off the wire and hurl and trip excess material. Make sure to leave plenty of room for the hackle and a small head.



Step 3: Wrap the hackle around the hook, tie off and remove excess material. Build a small head, whip finish and apply head cement.

You can also add a bead head or some lead wire on the body to help make the fly sink better.
